The One Year Introductory Program in Relational Studies is a two-semester theoretical and clinical program for post-graduate mental health professionals, taught by many of the founding and leading voices in Relational Psychoanalysis. Relational Psychoanalysis emerged as a confluence of object relational, interpersonal, and self-psychological perspectives, along with feminist and queer theory, critical race theory, and postmodern philosophy. In the One Year Program, we explore this wide breadth of ideas with many of the original relational theorists, including Jessica Benjamin, Tony Bass, Jody Davies, Adrienne Harris, Margaret Black Mitchell, Ken Corbett, and Joyce Slochower. Relational theory and clinical practice continue to evolve in vital ways, interrogating issues of race, class, community and intersectionality, taught by senior faculty including Michelle Stephens, Melanie Suchet, Kirkland Vaughans, Stephen Hartman, Annie Lee Jones and Rossanna Echegoyén.

The program is for students who want a comprehensive introduction to Relational Psychoanalysis or may be considering future psychoanalytic training. The program is open to licensed and license-eligible mental health professionals. Classes will meet via zoom at 7:00-9:15p EST on Thursday evenings from September, 2022, through May, 2023.

A letter of completion/CE certificate will be awarded upon successful participation in the program. Tuition for the academic year is \$2600.
